SGV MEMBERSHIP

The Objectives of the Society are:

1. To provide a forum for discussion and exchange of ideas on matters pertaining to the health, disease, nutrition and welfare of greyhounds;
2. To enhance the status of the veterinary profession within the greyhound industry;
3. To assist its members in negotiations with track managements & other bodies, regarding fees, facilities and other matters ;
4. To enter into negotiations/discussions with the GBGB, IGF, or their successors, and other public, professional and industry bodies and to promote the policies of the SGV, and similarly with any political organization;
5. To do all such other lawful things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of any of the above objects or in any way analogous thereto.

Membership

1. Ordinary Members shall be qualified members of the profession. Applications from veterinary surgeons qualified outside the UK are to be agreed by committee.
2. Associate Members may be non-members of the profession. Candidates for Associate Membership must apply in the same manner as prescribed for Ordinary Members. Applications will be considered by the Executive Committee.
3. Honorary Members. This class of membership includes Ordinary and Associate members. Normally former members who are retired may be accepted in this class, as will others invited by the committee.
